The event follows a series of successful international conferences organised by IIEA since its inception: SOAS (its inaugural conference, 2011), Bilgi University (2013), Boston College (2014), Philipps-University of Marburg (2016), the International Institute of Social History (2018), and University of Naples 'L'Orientale' (2019).

As on previous occasions, the purpose of this conference is to showcase the best current research on Iran's economy and to generate information and encouragement for future high-quality research in this area. The proposed topics may be in any field of economics, economic history and political economy. The Program Committee welcomes both empirical and theoretical papers that use quantitative or analytical narrative methods.

Financial support for travel and lodging costs for one presenter for each accepted paper will be available and details will be announced after the review process is completed. Conference fees will be waived for the authors of accepted papers, session chairs and discussants. Fees will be announced in due course too.
